Michael Geller - architect, planner, developer - offers his perspective on heritage and character home conservation in West Vancouver in a talk hosted by West Vancouver Historical Society. Join us on Wednesday, March 14, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. at the West Vancouver Seniors' Centre.

This is the latest in a series of talks on heritage conservation in our community hosted by WVHS. In 2015, Geller joined West Vancouver council members and staff, and community representatives to talk about neighbourhood character and options available to the community through West Vancouver's Community Heritage Register. In 2017, heritage conservationist and speaker, Donald Luxton, spoke on the importance and value of community heritage preservation.

Michael Geller will illustrate his talk with reference to his projects in West Vancouver: Hollyburn Mews, the Vinson Cottages and most recently, the Rush House.

Community character is reflected in our homes and buildings, gardens and neighbourhoods, and in the stories we tell about them. Can development and heritage conservation co-exist? We'll find out on Wednesday, March 14th.
